Traffic & Parking Committee Meeting

Trueblood Hall – DPS Training Room April 4, 2019

A motion was passed to increase parking ticket prices for blocking crosswalks and wheelchair ramps from \$20 to \$75. The increased fine will deter blocking restricted areas for those with disabilities to help avoid accidents and prevent students from being late to class.

LOT 4 (*Parking lot between Thompson Point and Communications Bldg.*) – A proposal was made to make Lot 4 Red and Green. This would allow commuter students to have better access to the Agriculture Building. Lot 4 is currently Green (overnight parking for students who live in the dorms at Thompson Point). Two-thirds of the lot would be Red and one-third green.

LOT 21 (*Parking near Woody Hall and Quigley Hall*) – A proposal was made to repave/renovate Lot 21 to create more parking spaces for faculty. The cost of the project is estimated at \$310,000.
