Civil Service Council Education Assistance Committee

The Education Assistance Committee met virtually on Wednesday, July 29, 2020.

New Business:

The committee discussed fundraising efforts conducted in the spring semester.

Quatro's – March 17th fundraiser – raised \$980.00, with 31/130 gift certificates left unsold. Tony received a check from Quatro's for our last fundraiser in the fall for \$845.00

Yankee Candle – Tony has collected \$145.95 total from that fundraiser.

We have around \$4800 total with the fundraisers, endowment, and payroll deductions right now.

Education Assistance Applications – We had 31 students total apply for fall 2020 awards. The Committee reviewed the applicants on the spreadsheet who had disqualifications and after a lengthy discussion, the Committee approved 24, with 6 pending. The reason for this is that some students are having trouble getting registered for classes (i.e. receiving overrides from departments, advisement, etc., due to the pandemic), or need to check with the Financial Aid office for further information. Tony made a motion to approve 31 applications, pending the students are deemed qualified after further review next week; Elizabeth -2^{nd} .

Tony believes we can award \$200 to each applicant and made a motion for this; Elizabeth -2^{nd} , motion passed.

Andrea Steen resigned as Chair of the Education Assistance Committee. She thanked everyone for helping her during her time as Chair, but the coming months for her are filled. Shannon said that after elections, we should see new members after the first of September. Tony volunteered to be the Interim Chair of the Education Assistance Committee, and hopefully appoint a new Chair in October. Anthony Fobs volunteered to take over as Chair in October, and shadow Tony during his Interim Chair role.
