Elections Committee

Members of the CSC Elections Committee met immediately following the February 6, 2013 Civil Service Council meeting. The committee evaluated the sectors from the list of civil service employees provided by Human Resources through Becky Armstrong and determined the following: 594 employees in the Provost and Vice Chancellor sector; 605 employees in the General sector; and 345 employees in the Auxiliary sector; for a total of 1,544 civil service employees. Based on these figures, the total number of Civil Service Council seats was determined to be: 6 in the Provost and Vice Chancellor sector; 6 in the General sector; and 3 in the Auxiliary sector. During evaluation of the number of seats to become vacant it was realized that due to job reassignment, Jesus Rosado, would not be eligible to be on the Elections Committee as his sector has changed and he will be required to rerun for a seat on the Civil Service Council. Based on expiring terms, job reassignment, and the need to fill vacant seats with three year term expirations, elections were required as follows for each sector: 2 seats for the Provost and Vice Chancellor sector (both 3-year terms); 2 seats for the General sector (both 3-year terms); and 1 seat for the Auxiliary sector (one 3-year term). Review and update of the Election Schedule was also finalized. The memorandums for the Annual Elections were signed by the Chair, and Becky Armstrong forwarded them to duplicating with labels arranged by sectors. Statement of Candidacy forms will be mailed to civil service employees on February 25, 2013.
