Naming University Facilities Committee

The committee met on October 7, 2013, and Dr. Dennis Cradit, Dean, College of Business, chaired.

James G. Salmo, Vice Chancellor for Development and Alumni Relations, presented a brief summary of a proposal to provide new guidelines for the operating of this committee. The current guidelines were approved back in 2000. A subcommittee examined several peer universities and decided that the procedures used by Indiana University would be useful as a basis for us. Some additions/revisions were made to adapt them for SIUC, and it has been submitted to the University Legal Counsel for review. If approved, it would increase the scope of the committee's review process to not only include facilities but also programs within schools. Also, within the overall committee, there would be two subcommittees, which would respectively investigate namings that are honorific or financially based, and then report their findings to the main committee.

The committee approved unanimously the removal of a name and addition of an honorific name to a university facility.

The committee also approved unanimously the recommended minimum donations for a various areas within a university facility.
